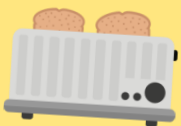
NS Breakfast Program

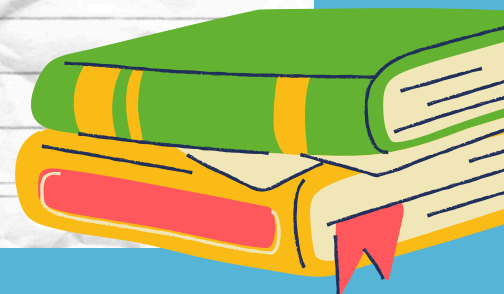
